



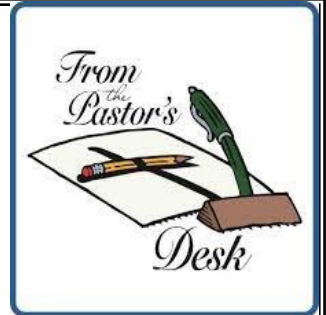

Made my bed. Put my plate in the sink after dinner. Took out the garbage." Then at the bottom he wrote, "Mom owes Johnny - \$15."

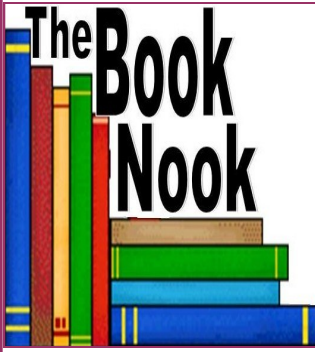
The next day when he came home from school he found \$15 on his bed. And next to it was a list of things his Mom had done for him titled. "Things Mom did for Johnny":

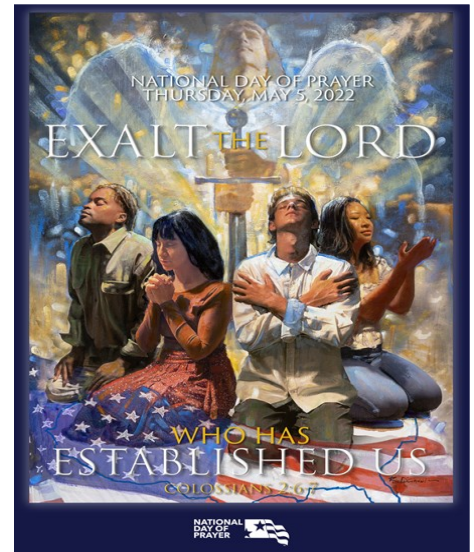
FBC Mothers Day 2022

Jochebed—Exodus 6:20; Numbers 26:59
Mother of Moses, Aaron and Miriam To save Moses' life she placed him, as an infant, in a basket that floated into the possession of the Pharaoh's daughter. Jochebed learned where the basket ended up and became the caretaker of her own child.

Abigail—(not David's sister) 1 Samuel 25
She saved David's life and after the death of her husband, married David.

Elisabeth—Luke 1: - 5-58
Mother of John the Baptist and the wife of Zacharias. Related to Mary, mother of Jesus.

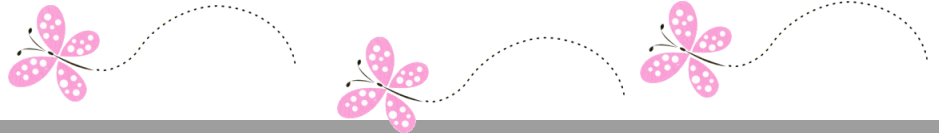
