Our nation - "God bless America, land that I love. Stand beside her and guide her through the night with the Light from Above". We sang this on Sunday and the words stayed with me. President Reagan gained fame in the early 80s by saying, "It's morning in America." He meant we'd be "Prouder, Stronger, Better" than we were after the Carter years. That became his campaign theme.



How many would say that now? We are going through a dark time. Will we make it "through the night"? How many Americans believe in or rely on "the Light from Above"? I'm convinced only turning to God will save us. But the good news is that God graciously accepts all who say they're sorry for how they've let Him and themselves down, and promises to heal and restore us. And He has the power to do it. We cannot make others turn to Him. How then can we bring about that spirit of repentance in other Americans? Through prayer. Let's pray for our country.

Time is our greatest resource.

My fear with phones is that they are so useful we keep them near us all the time, and their output indirectly robs us of our freedom to determine how we use our time. With so many texts + updates + news alerts + ads - do we really determine how we use our time? Don't these devices dictate how we use it? How can we find the time to concentrate on accomplishing our goals - to be truly self-directed - with all these other things distracting us? Are they

don't want to walk alone we can pair you up with a leader.





- Mark Sohmer Great News Ministry Mark continues to do evangelism on college campuses, and in Boston's subways, asking strangers to think about who God and Jesus are, and the claims they make. 
