When we had Hannah from Joni and Friends visit I left out a few key points in my message about special needs people - especially regarding Jesus' attitude t oward those who were disabled. We spoke of how He got "up close and personal" with sick people and "unclean foreigners" others wouldn't go near. That was gracious. But line that up next to what we saw of the Lord when we studied Revelation.

There, at the end of time, when the kingdom of this world becomes God's Kingdom, we saw vivid pictures of Christ majestically ruling over ALL - all other rulers, powers and kingdoms, worshiped, adored, feared even, by every being in creation, earthly or heavenly. So for One so great to show such care for people who are weak or incapable is a beautiful thing.

We asked the question, 'Why didn't Jesus' followers want the blind men to bother Him?' It may have been because they sensed He was the Messiah - this supernatural agent of God who would one day rule the earth in His place - and that for Him to interact with people who were disabled would be a misuse of His time. But for Jesus, caring for the less fortunate was key to His standing as the Savior/King. He came to serve as He said. And this is what He came to teach and prepare us, His Body, to do as well.
