A friend from Ohio sent me a note about forgiveness that his priest put in their weekly bulletin. In 1974 an 18 year old shot and killed 2 people in Akron. He was sentenced to death but that was changed to life in prison. This year, after 50 years in prison, he was up for parole, and expressed regret for his crime.

The son of the couple who were murdered, Dave Anthony, decided not to speak against parole at his hearing. He said he believed his parents would have forgiven him and he wanted to forgive him. But he also said he still grieves his parent's loss 50 years later, and offered a 'Mass intention' at my friend's church. It was given to honor both his grief and the grief of the killer and his family.

This kind of forgiveness is rare. A society needs justice. Crime - especially the taking of a life must be punished. But most of us - thankfully - won't be involved in serious crimes. We will be hurt though, sometimes intentionally, sometimes unintentionally. Can we forgive others from our hearts for those hurts and the pain they cause? Its the only way to a better, full, healthy relationship with others. To hold onto the pain hurts us more than it hurts them.

Colossians 2:13-15 - We "were dead in sins" but God gave us "a share in the very life of Christ, for He forgave all our sins...nailing them to Christ's cross." (The Living Bible)

Bible Studies


ADULT BIBLE STUDY – Sunday mornings at 9am. All are welcome to join. We are currently studying the Book of Esther.
