

Dave Gilcreast walked into our church 10 yrs ago and took over as Worship Leader/Music Director. His impact has been so great and his work such a blessing we have to pay tribute to him here, and to Stacey his wife and their daughter Taylor who also sang and played dozens of times.

Our choir had been 11 people or so at the time. Through Dave and Stacey's leadership it grew to over 20 within a year; and we grew in ability too. It sends a positive, important message to visitors when they see that many people in a choir. "There's life in this church." That leads to more people coming and honoring God. It spurred our growth here.

There are clear facts about Dave and Stacey's music ministry: They planned and played at over 500 worship services - using piano, organ, accordion, drum, violin, et al. They planned all the hymns and praise choruses, the offertories and special music, developing and coordinating many singers and musicians. They had praise song booklets compiled. Dave also procured handbells from another church and lead several handbell choirs in playing over the years. Dave found an organ repair person who rebuilt our organ at an incredibly fair price. When we were home-bound during Covid they recorded themselves singing and added that to our video services.

They lead almost 300 choir practices, each of which involved extensive preparation, collating of sheet music, and work with soprano, alto, tenor and bass groups. They put on 10 cantatas or Christmas concerts with over 30 singers from different churches requiring an additional half-dozen practices. They cheerfully invited new people to get involved. I cannot remember a time when they were late to anything. They lead prayer at every practice. And they had to work with, shall we say, a challenging range of personalities in the choir!

All of this had an impact on many people, in our church and outside it. The choir practices strengthened our church. To have 25 people singing/praising God weekly - worshiping really - learning and laughing together strengthened us spiritually. The people in the congregation or audience enjoyed the music and saw their quality work. That kept them coming back. It pointed them towards the Lord too. It amazed many of us how often Dave chose exactly the right songs to match the message in spite of us not planning that. The Holy Spirit at work.

Dave and Stacey also volunteered to lead music at VBS for several years. They arranged for the choir to sing at nursing homes. They visited seniors in their homes and sang for them.

Beyond these facts on a personal level they have been exemplary and deserve acclaim. Many times Dave stopped into the office to exchange ideas on music and worship. I'd ask his opinion on things as he was far more experienced, and he was an excellent sounding board. He talked me out of making some very dumb decisions guite a few times.

Both of them came from great families and were devoted to them. They are obviously loving parents to Taylor, doing concerts and trips together. I know Dave visited his Mom Shirley in a care facility regularly, was close to his Dad John before his death, and was a great support to his older siblings. Stacey's parents are still living, and she has a wonderful relationship with them.

There were many other unseen acts of kindness they did for many here, and for friends from other churches and from work. One I know of was Dave driving 40 minutes to drop off soup for me when I had Covid.

We haven't even touched on the other churches they served in Manchester, Danville, etc. Nor have we talked about their long careers as educators in Londonderry, Pelham and Derry! Add it all together and it is not too much to say that these 2 impacted the lives of thousands of people in southern New Hampshire.

I was involved at the Londonderry Presbyterian Church when Dave started his career - at the age of 15! Even then he had the ability and desire to serve the Lord, and took charge of large portions of the music program there. He was naturally gifted but was also taught by his Mom, Shirley, who was organist there for 50 years. Adding his 40 years of Christian service to her's and that equals almost a century of lifting up the name of the Lord in music. What a heritage and an example to others.

Please join us after worship on September 22 as we honor their time here.

Since we had extra monies thanks to your generous giving, we approved additional amounts for Valerie Markowski in South Africa, the Gunbhardi's in Albania, the Hoovers nursing home work, and Camp Sentinel in Moultonborough. We also voted to give special gifts to 2 ministries - a local pastor, Vallerian Mganga, Southside Bible Church, for his trip to Kenya to train leaders there, and the Mt Zion Christian School. All these were in the \$200-\$500 range. We plan to meet with the Gunbardhi's when they're here in November. And we are looking for a ministry that provides help in Ukraine.






