
Bonhoeffer Movie


Women's Wednesday Bible Study


Tuesday Night Bible Study


It was wonderful to be with our missionaries from Albania,
Lorena and Marin Gunbardhi, in November. They gave the same
slide presentation they gave here to pastors, missions groups and
individuals from 7 southern NH churches that week, and every
one was impressed with their spirit and what God has done
there.

It was also great to meet the people at these churches, including
2 large ones in Nashua. One gets almost 1,500 people on a
Sunday, and the other hosts worship services for Indian, Brazilian
and Slavic congregations. NH has certainly become diverse.

It was refreshing to hear them talk about how attractive the gospel is to people in Albania, most of whom came out of atheism or Islam. We see so little of that in America. We need to pray for God to call more people to faith, including our own friends and family. That will be the theme of our prayer time on Thursday December 3, praying for those not-yet Christ followers.
